

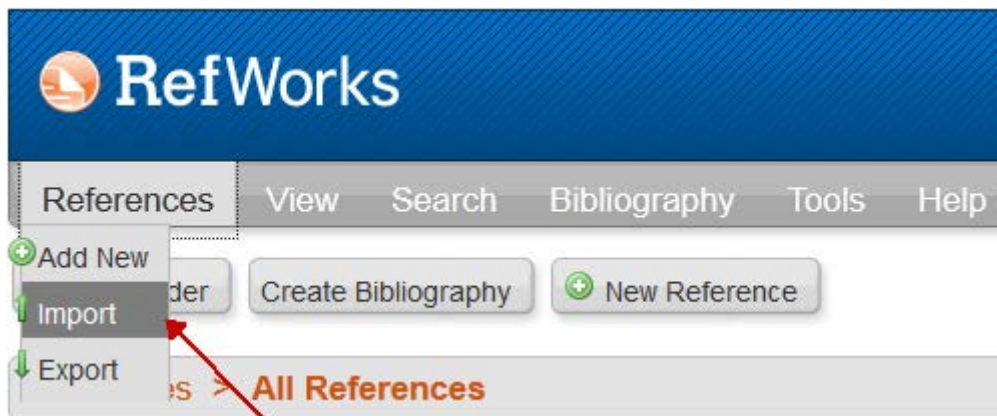
Download Your References from PubMed

1. Perform a search in [PubMed](#).
2. Check the boxes next to articles you want to download. Use the [PubMed Clipboard](#) to select article records from multiple searches.
3. Click the "**Send to**" link.
4. Select **Citation Manager** under Choose Destination
5. Click the **Create File** button.
6. Save the file, **citations.nbib**, to your computer.
7. Or open the file and select all **text** and **copy**



Step 2: Importing into RefWorks

1. Login to your RefWorks database.
2. Mouse over the **References** menu and select **Import**.



1. The **Import Reference** screen will appear.
2. Select **NLM PubMed** from the **Import Filter/Data Source** drop-down list.
3. **Browse** to find the text file from PubMed that you saved to your computer.
4. If you copied the text you can **paste** it in the box **From text**
5. Click on **Import**.
